
To ensure a stress-free, perfect build, we can provide the full construction service.

World famous in the 19th Century for his necessarily functional yet beautiful greenhouses, his attention to detail and drive for perfection did much to create and spread Britain's reputation for gardening around the globe.


Today all our greenhouses harness the finest modern materials, technology and craftsmanship as we continue to preserve this engineering legacy.

High maintenance timber greenhouses such as those in the grounds of listed properties, conservation areas and heritage sites are very costly to keep in working order, and often fall into disrepair, eventually becoming too decrepit for safe use.

As a part of our quest for perfection, 'The Messenger' greenhouse was created for a client in the 1990s in response to a growing demand for a faithful authentic timber replica in low maintenance aluminium, inside and out.

The Messenger is unique as the only aluminium greenhouse on the market which completely satisfies the demanding requirements in these situations. The development of a mechanism to hide all fixings within the body of the structure, an aluminium door which matches the beautiful timber doors in both look and weight, and a specialist clipping system which holds the glass in place without screws, has resulted in a greenhouse that answers the many needs of Britain's period manors, heritage sites and conservation officers.

In 2012, we were delighted to be endorsed by the world renowned Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew. Borne of years of friendship and mutual understanding, this dynamic collaboration will ensure that we stay at the forefront of greenhouse development, and the growing experience within.





CLASSIC GREENHOUSE STYLES

Historically a greenhouse is often the centre piece in a walled garden, and today many of our greenhouses still attach to walls. There are several ways to achieve this depending on wall height, and what you want to grow. A south facing wall provides extra warmth which is perfect for vines and fruit trees.

Alternatively it may be freestanding, giving complete freedom of location, height and design.



Greenhouse Collection

The National Trust Greenhouse Collection consists of eight freestanding designs with a choice of six heritage colours.



The National Trust's mission is to conserve and maintain the nation's heritage and open spaces for the benefit and enjoyment of everyone. Their mantra 'For ever, for everyone' is at the Trust's heart.

When looking for a greenhouse partner, the Trust looked no further than Alitex. We instinctively understood what the National Trust wanted to achieve: a practical, accessible, low-maintenance greenhouse with all the timeless aesthetic qualities of an original heritage structure that will stand the test of time.

The Collection comprises eight different designs in a choice of six carefully chosen colours and a multitude of internal options. All the National Trust greenhouses are free standing and incorporate all the beautiful design features of an original structure: 'timber' moulded glazing bars, ornate spandrels and cast vent gear, all made of low maintenance aluminium and guaranteed for life.

Each greenhouse sold generates valuable income which goes towards the wonderful restoration and conservation undertaken by the National Trust.



THE HIDCOTE


2.6m x 3m (8'5" x 10'1")



Ideal for the fruit and vegetable grower when limited garden space is available. It has room for one bench with beds on either side of the greenhouse.

THE SCOTNEY


2.6m x 4m (8'5" x 13'5")



With room for a bench on the gable end and along one side, there is enough space for one bed and plenty of pots.

THE STOURHEAD

2.6m x 5m (8'5" x 16'8")



Slightly longer than the Scotney, the Stourhead provides a really productive area for growing and display.




2.6m x 4m (8'5" x 13'5") with central flat fronted lobby

THE TATTON


2.9m x 5.1m (9'6" x 16'9")



Slightly wider than the Mottifont and fitted with an extended central lobby giving you more space and internal layout options.

THE WIMPOLE


2.9m x 6.4m (9'6" x 20'11")

THE CLIVEDEN


3.5m x 6.4m (11'5" x 20'11")



With extended feature lobby. The extra width of the Cliveden gives a very generously proportioned growing area, with the ultimate flexibility for layout.

THE ICKWORTH

2.9m x 7.1m (9'6" x 23'5")



Designed in a cruciform shape, with extended lobby on either side. This could work well if you want to delineate different areas of your garden.

We have worked in partnership with the National Trust since 2004 and in that time have met many of the dedicated and skilled team who work for them. We have built a number of bespoke greenhouses at National Trust properties including Sizergh Castle, Avebury Manor, Peckover House, The Vyne, Woolbeding Gardens, Greys Court and Standen House. Growing space

THE ULTIMATE GROWING EXPERIENCE...

As well as creating a stunning focal point to any garden, our horticultural expertise ensures that your greenhouse will be absolutely fit for purpose - the ultimate growing experience. Before we start your greenhouse design, we work with you to fully understand what and how you want to grow. This will guide the design and style of the structure.

Once designed, the next step is to plan the internal fixtures and fittings, and make sure you can create the correct combination of heat, light and ventilation to achieve that optimum 'buoyant' atmosphere for your plants to thrive.

As a default we include the maximum amount of manually controlled side vents and thermostatically controlled roof vents necessary to ensure perfect ventilation.

External blinds are the best way of controlling heat and light. Ours are made of a woven aluminium and nylon material, and crucially hang on the outside. Used in tandem with the side and roof vents, they are the most effective way of preventing your greenhouse from overheating and controlling your growing temperatures.

Controlled heat is then achieved with either mobile electric fan heaters with a thermostatic control, or in larger greenhouses (and when you require higher temperatures), a comprehensive 'wet' boiler-run heating system.

THE RIGHT STRUCTURE FOR YOUR PLANTS

Providing the perfect growing environment for vines and soft fruit can be achieved by creating a lean-to glasshouse against a new or existing wall. The extra warmth retained by a south facing wall will ensure your fruit is evenly ripened and the sweet summery smell will stay with you for hours. The degree of slope to the roof, in conjunction with designed ventilation, reduces dreaded fungal disease - maximising airflow whilst retaining heat is the objective.

If you would like to create different temperature zones within one greenhouse, we can provide you with a multitude of options for plant collections by partitioning off separate growing areas. It is perfectly possible to take a horticultural 'trip around the world', within one glasshouse - and still have a well appointed seating area from which to enjoy the view.

THE FITTINGS TO HELP YOU MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR GREENHOUSE

The **FELL EXTERNAL SHADE** is the most effective method of protection from the sun, both preventing scorch and reducing the amount of heat getting into the structure.



The **MESSENGER VICTORIAN BENCHING** is deep enough to allow for a generous layer of water retentive hydroleca, they can be fitted free standing or attached to the wall. It also provides a useful lower shelf for storage.

The **MALLERY TIERED DISPLAY BENCH** will show off your plants at their best.

The **INTERNAL RESERVOIR** provides an ambient, soft, convenient and easily extracted water supply collected from the roof of the greenhouse.




The **HEATHLANDS COLD FRAME** is kept cooler than the greenhouse and used for seedlings, protecting frost-sensitive cuttings and acclimatising garden-bound plants thereby extending your growing season. They can be part of, or separate to, the main structure.



ORNAMENTAL FLOOR GRATING is a real Victorian classic, cast iron grids that cover the heating ducts, as well as looking stunning.



The **ALITEX GLASSHOUSE HEATER** is robust and effective, it provides either 1.0kW, 1.8kW or 2.8kW of thermostatically controlled heat output.

Continual investment in our products, processes and people is one of the keys to our success. From top of the range design software, to large investment in our factory and company wide team building activities - we continually strive to improve.


ALUMINIUM MADE BEAUTIFUL

Aluminium provides all the beauty of wood, but without the drawbacks - it is light and easy to handle yet strong, being able to withstand extremes of weather. But perhaps even more important for today's busy lifestyles, it requires virtually no maintenance.

It requires none of the scraping, sanding and repainting of timber. It 'moves' far less than timber so the glass will not work its way loose, hinges and moving parts do not require continual adjustment and nothing degrades.

It is the perfect material for a greenhouse. It also allows for the minimum solid structure to be used, giving you narrow elegant structural bars and the maximum glazed area to optimise light all year round. To enhance its finish and longevity our aluminium structures are polyester powder coated at our factory. The polyester is applied as a powder then heated to its melting point. It then flows to form a smooth film which dries to a firm durable finish which is highly resistant to scratching, cracking, peeling, UV rays and rust. This application also provides a superior consistency and a uniform finish in virtually any colour.

INTELLIGENT DESIGN - PRECISION ENGINEERING

It is a combination of intelligent design, precision engineering and old-fashioned craftsmanship that ensures we create greenhouses of such structural integrity, they can withstand the elements around the world - as far afield as Japan, Nova Scotia, Chile and Russia.

Our designers use the latest 3D computer aided design software programmes to construct your 'virtual' greenhouse to ensure it will look as good as it will perform. Our engineers use computer aided analysis to make sure all structures are designed in accordance with relevant wind and snow loads and regional standards. For example British Standards (BS5502, BS6388, BS8119, and BS1474).

And, more importantly, to live up to our lifetime guarantee.

State of the art CAD-CAM software then translates your design to our CNC machines. In layman's terms, that means computer aided manufacturing for improved accuracy and final 'fit' of the parts when we install your greenhouse in your garden.



QUALITY CONTROL

At Alitex the team are immensely proud of the enduring quality of our greenhouses and work tirelessly to ensure every greenhouse that leaves us undergoes stringent quality controls. Key check points throughout our design, manufacture and build process give us further confidence in providing a lifetime structural guarantee.

All components of manufacture are checked against the drawing office technical specifications throughout the process and we double check our computerised systems - you can never be too sure. Approximately 80% of our structures are assembled at our premises prior to painting,

identifying any unlikely anomalies and rectifying them before they leave. All jobs are scratched and acid tested at key stages of the paint process. All elements are manually checked before being packaged for dispatch to you.



Aftercare

An Alitex greenhouse is undoubtedly a significant investment and will become a special retreat for all who use it. You'll hopefully now realise that our greenhouses are all about growing, and not about maintenance, but from time to time you may find that the structure and the working parts need some care and attention.

Part of our commitment to you is the aftercare we provide once your greenhouse is in place. We have a dedicated department that looks after small works and servicing.

Despite having toughened glass, an errant cricket ball has been known to cause a pane or two to break. We keep all your details on file so we can easily identify the pane of glass, have it made and swiftly sent to you.

Our clean and care service ensures that your greenhouse continues to be a clean and pest free optimum growing environment. We are not suggesting that washing the glass down at the end of the season needs a crack team, just that after a couple of years, algae can form in the nooks and crannies and that is when you need to get in the professionals.



Often customers come back to us asking to retrospectively fit a range of accessories or extras to improve the use of their greenhouse. Vine wires, display benching, even cat flaps - we can retro fit an array of fittings to suit your changing needs. We have even been known to relocate greenhouses when owners have moved house.

We also have customers that want something a little different designed for their greenhouse - from a telescopic dwarf greenhouse to some rather impressive strawberry gantries. The team's mantra is never to say no until we have looked at it first - they are a resourceful bunch of people - there is certainly a will and we always endeavour to find a way!


